Is Christianity a Religion? -47

His emphasis on justification by faith spotlighted Jesus as the ultimate mediator, stressing that faith in Jesus is the only way to attain salvation, making His mission personal and accessible to all. Luther's sola fide (faith alone) mantra underscored Jesus' redemptive work, focusing on individual salvation and a direct, unmediated relationship with God, emphasizing the transformative power of faith in a living, loving Savior.

2. John Calvin (1509-1564):

John Calvin (1509-1564), a French theologian, understood Jesus' mission in human history as the fulfillment of God's eternal plan to redeem His elect. Jesus, the Son of God, humbled Himself to become human, obeying God's law perfectly and bearing the wrath of God on the cross as a substitutionary sacrifice. Calvin saw Jesus' mission as a demonstration of God's sovereignty and love, securing salvation for the chosen through His death and resurrection, and empowering believers to live out their faith in a world He has already redeemed.

Domestic Church: Family as Cornerstone of the Kingdom-1

Introduction

Despite their diminutive size, bees exert an influence on the biosphere and on human survival that far exceeds their physical scale. As primary pollinators, bees enable the reproduction of an estimated 87.5% of the world's flowering plants and underpin the productivity of approximately 75% of major global food crops, including fruits, vegetables, nuts, and oilseeds that provide essential vitamins and micronutrients. Consequently, the extinction of bees would not merely reduce agricultural yields; it would erode dietary diversity, compromise nutritional security, and trigger cascading failures across terrestrial ecosystems, since the majority of wild plant species also depend on animal-mediated pollination. The often-cited, though apocryphal, remark attributed to Einstein—"If the bee disappeared off the surface of the globe, then man would have only four years of life left"—captures this systemic vulnerability: the removal of a seemingly minor component precipitates the destabilization of a much larger structure.

In an analogous manner, the family unit, though the smallest constituent of human society, functions as its foundational cornerstone. It is within the family that individuals are born, nurtured, and socialized; where language, moral reasoning, and relational capacities are first cultivated; and where the basic mechanisms of social trust and intergenerational continuity are sustained. Just as bees sustain the ecological web through pollination, the family sustains the social order by forming its members capable of cooperation, responsibility, and civic life.
